How preventing corona from infecting us as follows:-

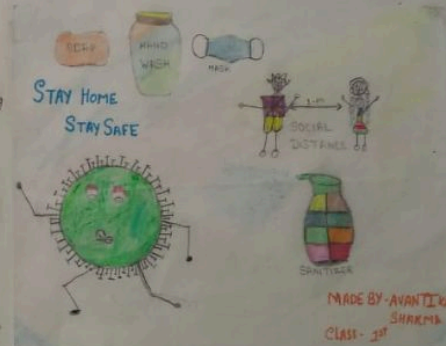
- 1) Wash your hands regularly with soap and water or disinfectant with alcohol.
- 2) Maintain at least 2 meter distance between you and people coughing or sneezing
- 3) Cover your mouth and nose when coughing or sneezing
- 4) Refrain from smoking and other activities that weaken the lungs
- 5) Practice physical distancing by avoiding unnecessary travel and staying away from large groups of people.
- 6) Avoid touching your face and stay home if you feel unwell.

Ques: What is corona virus?

Ans: Coronaviruses are large group of virus that cause illness in human and animals. They include common cold, SARS and MERS. The spread between people such as has been with MERS and SARS.

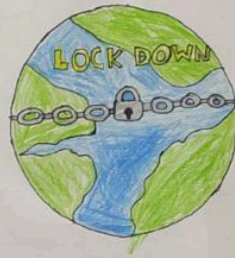
Ques: What is Covid-19?

Ans: Covid-19 is a disease that causes respiratory illness and recover without requiring special treatment. Some people and their children develop medical problems like cardiovascular disease, diabetes, chronic respiratory disease, and cancer are more likely to develop serious illness. The Covid-19 virus spreads primarily through droplets of saliva or discharge from the nose when an infected person coughs or sneezes. So it's important that you also practice respiratory etiquette (for example by coughing into a flexed elbow).

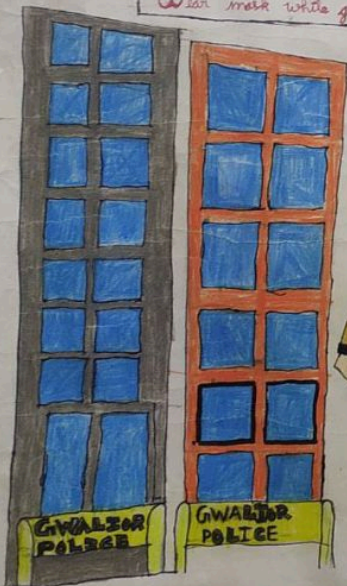

- Manufacturers have been hit, and the world trade volume could once again plummet this year.

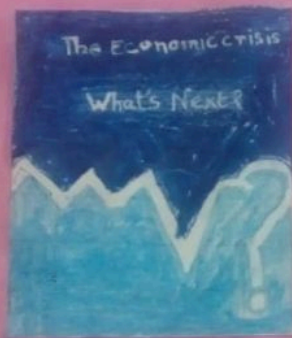
Financial Crisis is on its way.
